

Summary guide to all HESA data available for analysis in heidi

Updated 17 October 2011



This summary guide represents the structure of the heidi data explorer, located within the 'create report' facility within heidi. It comprises a series of tables for each category of data in heidi. The folder name of where these tables can be found in heidi are listed in the title for reference.

The fields in bold, which feature at the top of the columns, display the route through the data explorer required to access the fields featured below. The number displayed in brackets against each field represents the number of categories available for further breakdown. The fields available for analysis as *either* column type or row type are shown separately at the bottom of each field list.

Please note that not all fields in each column are available to analyse against one another.

This summary guide is based on the latest year of data available within heidi. The data may change between years however. Guidance on significant changes or unavailability of data is listed in the final column of each table under the heading of 'Notes'.
